We encourage pupils at Ysgol Penygelli School to wear their uniform with pride as it demonstrates that we are part of the school community. We have high expectations from our pupils with regards to school uniform and appearance, and strongly believe that our high standards promote positive behaviour, equality, supports effective teaching and learning and contributes to the ethos of the school.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

We encourage all our children to wear their school uniform smartly. All items of uniform **must** be labelled with your child's name. It consists of the following:

- Green sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo;
- White polo shirt with school logo;
- Green polo shirts/ sweatshirts without Logos are permitted;
- Grey or black trousers/skirt;
- Green and white gingham summer dress/grey or black shorts;
- Sensible, black flat shoes (high heels are not permitted);
- Black trainers, without logos, are acceptable as a temporary alternative.

PE KIT

We require that our pupils change for PE activities. They need an appropriately labelled PE kit consisting of the following:

- Trainers/ plimsolls;
- White, round neck T-shirt with or without school logo;
- Black shorts;
- Black or blue tracksuit/joggers for outdoor games in cold weather.

PE kit should be brought to school on Monday mornings and taken home on Fridays. This will allow flexibility for their class teacher.

JEWELLERY

- Jewellery should not be worn or brought into school. The school will consider exceptions based on religious observance following discussion with parents and Governors.
- If pupils have pierced ears, ONE pair of discreet studs may be worn. **Earrings must be removed for PE lessons.** The taping of earrings for PE is not acceptable for health and safety reasons. If your child is unable to remove the earrings themselves, they should not come to school with them in on PE days.
- No other body piercings are allowed.

HAIRSTYLES AND MAKE UP

- Hair should be natural colour.
- Long hair to be tied back.
- Hair should not be excessively short, tramlines, patterns and sculpting are not allowed.
- Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school.

Non-compliance with the uniform and appearance policy: Staff should refer non-compliance to a member of the Senior Leadership Team. Parents of students who do not wear the correct uniform may be

contacted to bring in a change of clothes for their child or, in extreme cases, to collect their child from school.
